## Tally Room Operation

The State Electoral Office has committed to the use of an “electronic” tally board for use at the State Sports Centre.

The Board will consist of four rear projection screens and will replace the previous wooden Tally Board. One third of the 93 districts will be displayed at one time (for about 2 minutes) spread across the four boards (so about 8-9 districts/screen) and will scroll to the next one third and finally the last third. One complete cycle of the boards (6 minutes) will see a refresh of the results.

The results displayed on the boards will be supplemented by photocopy handouts of the results of all districts on regular (20 - 25 minutes) intervals.

## Electronic Feed of Results

The site <ftp.seo.nsw.gov.au> has been established to provide members of the public and media direct access to files containing election results for the 2003 NSW State General Election.

Results will be placed into sequentially numbered files which will reside in the LAFiles (Legislative Assembly) and LCFiles (Legislative Council) directories on this site. Election night results files will be available from 6pm on the evening of the 22 March 2003, while final Check Count results should become available on Sunday the 23 March 2003.

New LA and LC result files will only be placed on this site as new data becomes available, or about every 3 to 5 minutes during peak data entry periods.

The files on the site contain 1st Preference and Two Candidate Preferred results for the Legislative Assembly and the total 1st Preference results for the Legislative Council. These files have been formatted in accordance with the specifications contained in the File Layouts directory.

## Internet Access to Results

A Web site has been established by the NSW State Electoral Office to display results for the NSW State General Election to be held on 22 March 2003.

That Web site is at [www.election.nsw.gov.au](http://www.election.nsw.gov.au)

Results for all Electoral Districts will be progressively updated as they become available. The results will be refreshed every few minutes following the close of polling.

## Writs

Every election is held in accordance with writs.

A writ is a document by which the Governor (or the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly in the case of by-elections) directs Returning Officers to conduct an election.

The Governor issues writs on the advice of the Government.

Writs for a general election of members of the Legislative Assembly must be issued within 4 days after either:

- the proclamation dissolving the Assembly has been published in the Government Gazette; or
- the date of the expiration of the Assembly, that is, on the completion of the 4 year term

The writ for a periodic Legislative Council election cannot be issued until after the issue of the writs for a general election of members of the Legislative Assembly. The date for the taking of the poll for a periodic Council election must be the same as that for the general election of members to the Legislative Assembly.

Writs specify:

- the date by which nominations must be made;
- the date for the taking of the poll (polling day);
- the date by which the writ must be returned

Each Returning Officer is required to give public notice of the information contained on the writ.

All writs are required to be returned to the Governor within 60 days after their date of issue unless directed to be later by the Governor by notice in the Government Gazette.

Each Returning Officer is required to certify on the writ, and thereby give official notice to the Governor, the name of the elected candidate for each Legislative Assembly writ and the names of the elected candidates for the Legislative Council writ.

The issue and return of the writs represents the official beginning and end of any election.

## Representation

Each Member of the Legislative Assembly is elected to represent one of the 93 electoral districts in New South Wales. In a General Election, elections are held in each district so that the electors can elect a representative for their district.

Each electoral district has a Returning Officer who is appointed by the Governor. There are 93 Returning Officers in New South Wales, that is, one Returning Officer for each electoral district.

The 42 members of the Legislative Council represent the whole State. The Electoral Commissioner is the Returning Officer for periodic Legislative Council Elections.

## Nominations

### *Legislative Assembly*

The Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act 1912 provides that only a person who is enrolled in New South Wales may be nominated as a candidate.

There are two methods whereby a person may be nominated as a candidate for a Legislative Assembly electoral district – by 15 persons enrolled in the electoral district to be contested or by a party registered under the Act.

### **Nomination Deposit**

All nominations must be accompanied by a deposit of \$250.

### **Refund of Nomination Deposit**

After the election the deposit will be refunded to the candidate where the candidate is elected or receives at least 4% of the total number of first preference votes at the election.

### **Withdrawal of a Nomination**

A candidate may withdraw a nomination by signed notice to the Returning Officer delivered before noon on nomination day – a candidate cannot withdraw after that time.

### *Legislative Council*

The Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act 1912 provides that only a person who is enrolled as a voter in New South Wales may be nominated as a candidate.

There are two methods whereby a person or persons may be nominated – by 15 persons enrolled in New South Wales or by a party registered under the Act.

## **Nomination Deposit**

The nomination deposit is \$500 for each candidate. The only exception is that the deposit for candidates making up a group having 11-21 members is fixed at \$5,000. Set out below are examples of the nomination deposit provisions:-

- Group having 7 candidates - deposit of \$3,500 (\$500 x 7)
- Group having 16 candidates - deposit of \$5,000 (each candidate notionally lodging \$312.50 i.e. \$5,000)
- Group having 25 candidates - deposit of \$12,500 (\$500 x 25)

## **Refund of Nomination Deposit**

After the election the deposit will be refunded to the candidate where:

- • The candidate is elected; or
- • One of the candidates in the group of which he or she is a member is elected; or
- • The total number of first preference votes in his or her favour or in favour of members of the group in which he or she is a member is at least 4% of the total number of first preference votes at the election.

## **Withdrawal of a Nomination**

A candidate may withdraw a nomination by signed notice to the Electoral Commissioner delivered before noon on nomination day. However a person who is a member of a group cannot withdraw a nomination unless all others in the group consent by signing a withdrawal notice. A candidate cannot withdraw after noon on nomination day.

## **Grouping of Candidates**

Two or more candidates nominated for the Legislative Council election wishing to form a group must lodge with the Electoral Commissioner a claim form to have their names included in a group on the ballot-paper by no later than noon on nomination day.

## **Voting for the Legislative Assembly**

Each member of the Legislative Assembly is elected to represent an electoral district of New South Wales. In an election for the Legislative Assembly, or Lower House as it may be referred to, you can only vote for the candidates seeking election for the electoral district in which you are enrolled.

Members of the Legislative Assembly are elected for a maximum term of 4 years.

### ***Method Of Voting***

The method of voting for the Legislative Assembly is known as “optional preferential”.

You must place the number “1” in the square next to the name of the candidate for whom you wish to give your first preference vote.

Optional preferential means that you have the option of allocating further preferences. You can vote for additional candidates by placing consecutive numbers, beginning with the number “2”, in the squares next to the names of those additional candidates in order of your preference for them.

The names of each candidate and their political party affiliation are shown on the ballot paper.

### ***How Votes Are Counted***

To be elected, a candidate must obtain more than half of the votes in the count. First, all the number ‘1’ votes are counted for each candidate. These are called ‘first preference’ votes. If a candidate has more than half the total first preference votes, that candidate is elected.

If no candidate has more than half the first preferences, the candidate with the fewest votes is excluded. That candidate’s votes are moved on to the other candidates according to the second preference (the 2’s) shown by voters on that candidates ballot papers. Ballot papers which only show a first preference vote are excluded and are not considered as part of the count.

This process progresses excluding the candidate with the fewest votes until one candidate has more than half the total votes remaining in the count and is declared elected.

If more than one candidate is excluded it is probable that in excluding further candidates the ballot papers will be distributed at the third or fourth preference and so on as necessary.

## **Voting for the Legislative Council**

The New South Wales Legislative Council, or Upper House as it may be referred to, consists of 42 Members who represent the whole State in Parliament. At each general election 21 members are elected to serve two terms of Parliament, that is, a maximum of 8 years.

### ***Method Of Voting***

The method of voting for the Legislative Council is known as “optional preferential proportional representation” and is prescribed in the sixth schedule to the Constitution Act 1902.

The names of the candidates are shown on the ballot paper. If endorsed by a registered political party their affiliation with that party is also shown.

A Group must comprise at least 15 candidates before it can have a Group Voting Square above the thick black line. Candidates not included in a group are shown in a column on the extreme right of the ballot paper. These are generally referred to as the “Ungrouped Candidates”.

The Group or Party determines the order of candidates within their group on the ballot paper, but the order in which the Groups or Parties appear on the ballot paper is determined by a draw conducted by the Electoral Commissioner who is the Returning Officer for the election.

You may vote in one of two ways:

### **Above The Line**

You may vote:

- by placing the number '1' in one of the Group Voting squares located above the thick black line on the ballot paper. This will record a vote for the first candidate in that group with the preferences going to the other candidates in that Group only; or
- by placing the number '1' in a Group Voting Square then marking a second or subsequent preference in other Group Voting squares above the line. In this case you will have indicated preferences for candidates in the second and subsequent groups for the candidates in those groups in the order they appear on the ballot paper.

### **Below The Line**

Persons voting below the line must select their own order of preferences by placing the numbers '1', '2', '3', '4', '5', '6', '7', '8', '9', '10', '11', '12', '13', '14', '15' in the squares next to the names of 15 candidates in order of their preference for them. Persons can vote for additional candidates by placing consecutive numbers beginning with the number '16' in the squares next to the names of those additional candidates in order of their preference for them.

### ***How Votes Are Counted***

In order to be elected, candidates generally need to obtain a quota (about 4.5%) of the total formal votes cast in an election. The quota is determined by using a formula set out in the Constitution Act. Those candidates who receive a number of first preference votes that is equal to or greater than this quota are elected. The quota figure remains the same for the whole count. Any votes a candidate receives above the quota are known as surplus votes and may be transferred to the remaining candidates according to the next available preference shown on them. A transfer value (using a formula also set out in the Constitution Act) is applied to the distributed votes generally with



a value less than 1. The ballot papers being transferred are selected at random.

If there are no more surplus votes to transfer (or subject to other conditions in the count), but not all 21 Members have been elected, the ballot papers of the candidate with the lowest number of votes are transferred according to the next available preference shown on them. A transfer value is not applied to votes transferred at this stage and thus the votes have full value, that is, a value of 1.

The process continues until all 21 Members of the Legislative Council have been elected.
