Mr LINGARD asked the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice (Mr Welford) -

QUESTION:

With reference to my correspondence to him on 20 June and 25 July 2003 outlining the concerns of Amelia Belbin who believes that she is facing emotional and financial traumas because Crown Law is failing to allow a civil matter to be heard in the Supreme Court –

Will his department answer my correspondence so that I can provide advice to my constituent?

ANSWER:

Crown Law has prepared for me an in-depth memorandum detailing the background to Ms Belbin's case and a chronology of the progress of the matter.

I have now replied in writing to the Honourable Member for Beaudesert, outlining the actions taken by Crown Law in relation to this matter.
