

These kits are vital when school is disrupted due to emergency situations.

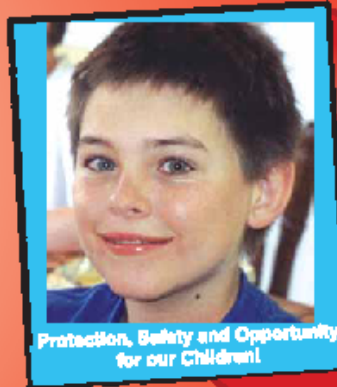
Over half of primary school aged students leave school before completing grade five. Many of them are girls, orphans, or otherwise particularly vulnerable children, such as those affected by HIV/AIDS. Without an education, the situation for these children is unlikely to get better.

UNICEF education projects in Mozambique help establish Child Friendly Schools, which get children into school and keep them there by providing an integrated school package, including essentials such as health and sanitation facilities. The Child Friendly School initiative also engages community participation to support children enrolling in and staying in school.
