Applications for leave under the *Service and Execution of Process Act* 1982

Consideration of applications for leave to serve Directions to Produce outside New South Wales, pursuant to the *Service and Execution of Process Act* 1982 involves the exercise of judicial power.

It is essential that adequate reasons for service of the direction outside the State be given in the application.

In the absence of adequate reasons being provided by the applicant, the granting of leave is unable to be considered by the Judge.

It is also essential that applications have attached to them the SEPA notice to the Producer. There must be one notice per direction.

Use of the Commission's photocopying facilities

Solicitors and agents are reminded again of Commission Rule 59(b) requiring the Commission to provide photocopying facilities in respect only of material produced under Direction, and Commission E-Bulletins Nos. 6 (February 2003) and 14 (June 2004) regarding use of copying facilities for materials produced pursuant to Direction only.

Use of the photocopying facilities for other purposes is not permitted.

Appropriate action will be taken against solicitors or agents who are identified as using the Commission's photocopier to copy material other than that produced pursuant to a Direction for Production.
