## Werribee recycled water scheme set to save drinking water

City West Water, the Victorian Government and Wyndham City Council recently announced that recycled water will be available for the Werribee Technology Precinct in early 2007.

The \$1.78 million funding announcement means that Class A recycled water will be available to irrigate Systems Golf Park, the Victoria University's sports ovals and gardens, Wyndham City Council parklands, Heathdale Christian College, Werribee Racing Club and washing down of animal enclosures at the University of Melbourne Veterinary College.

The Class A recycled water will be supplied through a 8.7km pipeline from Melbourne Water's Western Treatment Plant to the Werribee Technology Precinct.

It is estimated that the project will save 395 million litres of drinking water each year.
